
# PROSTRIP01 Rotary Cable Stripper and Cutter





Warning:- Sharp blades, please ensure you keep your fingers away from the blades and cutter area at all times.

## **Coaxial Cable Stripper**

Reversible cassette: one side is for RG59/RG6, other side for RG7/RG11.

# Tip: Spend time on a spare piece of cable setting the tool up.

- 1. Insert the cable until it aligns with the cable guide.
- 2. Rotate the tool 2-3 times using the finger ring. If the tool is set-up correctly you will hear two clicks as the outer and inner sheathes of cable are cut.
- 3. Open the jaws and remove the cable.
- 4. Pull away the outer jacket and dielectric to expose the inner conductor.

### **Round Cable Stripper**

For UTP, STP or networking cable.

- 1. Insert the cable into the hole shown and rotate 1-3 times anti-clockwise.
- 2. Open the jaws and remove the outer jacket.
- 3. The black colour adjusting knob adjusts the blade. Turn clockwise to increase the blade's depth and anti -clockwise to decrease.

#### Flat Cable Stripper

For stripping flat cables, including telephone cables.

- 1. Insert the cable between the stripper blades.
- a. Insert 4P/6P cable into the two-bladed part of the tool as indicated until it touches the stop guide.
- b. Insert 8P cable into the two-bladed part of the tool and let it extend a little past the lower cut blade.
- 2. Then squeeze handles (cable must be kept perpendicular) and pull from tool.

#### **Cable Cutter**

For cutting coaxial cable, round networking cable or flat telephone cable, place the cable in position and then squeeze the handles.
